COVID-19 Code of Conduct Appendix to the Behaviour Policy

In light of the changes that have been made due to COVID-19 this Annex is to ensure the behaviour and expectations of students allows for the safe learning environment for students and staff.

In addition to the school Code of Conduct I agree to support the school in ensuring my child follows the following procedures, including the consequences outlined.

Students will be expected to:

- sit in the advised seats on the bus maintaining social distancing following the drivers instructions at all times
- follow the guidelines of staff members when arriving at school - including going directly their designated learning area, observing 2 meters distancing when queuing, waiting for a member of staff before entering a classroom, and being observant that only one person maybe in at the toilet at a time – this means you may need to wait outside before entering.
- Follow guidelines from members of staff on washing hands, using hand sanitiser, coughing and sneezing – using a tissue where possible and following the principles of ‘catch it – bin it – kill it’
- Only socialise within their ‘bubble’ whilst maintaining social distancing, and ensuring that they do not share equipment, food, water bottles or any other item.
- Move around the school as per specific instructions (for example, one-way systems, not being in areas which are out of bounds and queuing).
- Entering and exiting classrooms through the correct doors.

Intentionally failing to follow the above guidelines will result in a verbal warning from a member of staff if deemed necessary they will removed from their teaching group and parents will be contacted to pick up their child straight away. Should a pupil repeatedly and intentionally fail to adhere to the code of conduct we will need to review the suitability and safety of that pupil continuing to attend school.

Similarly, should a student persistently demonstrate that they are unable (constantly forgetting) to follow the above guidelines parents will be notified and their place in school will be discussed and reviewed due to health and safety reasons.

Any of the below actions by students will result in students being removed from their learning environment and parents will be expected to collect their child from school as soon as possible:

- Spitting or coughing at or towards another person
- Meeting up with students from other groups
- Refusing to follow instructions of a member of staff putting others at risk

Additionally students will be expected to:

- tell an adult if they are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus
- bring with them the appropriate equipment for learning, including a water bottle and a supply of tissues
