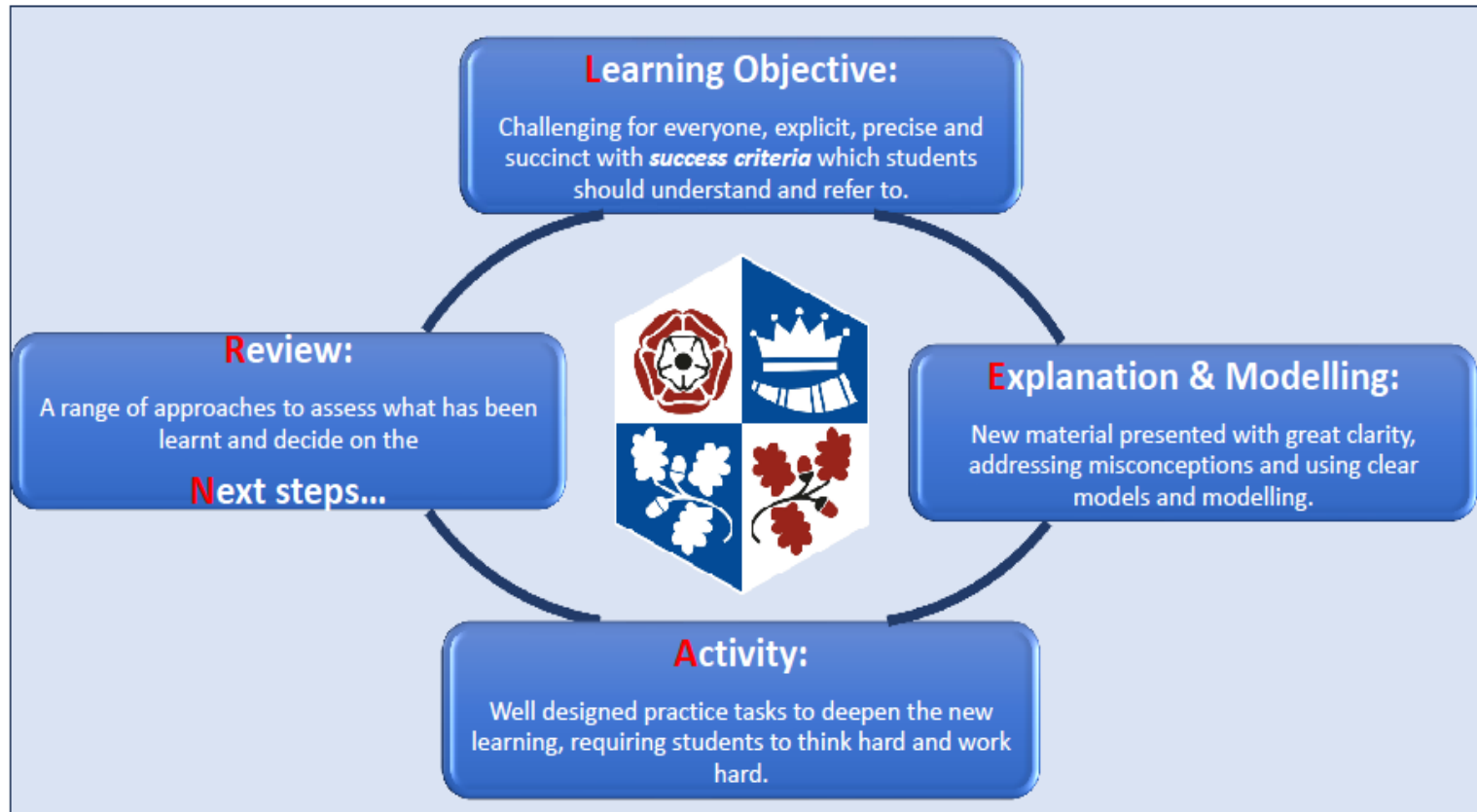

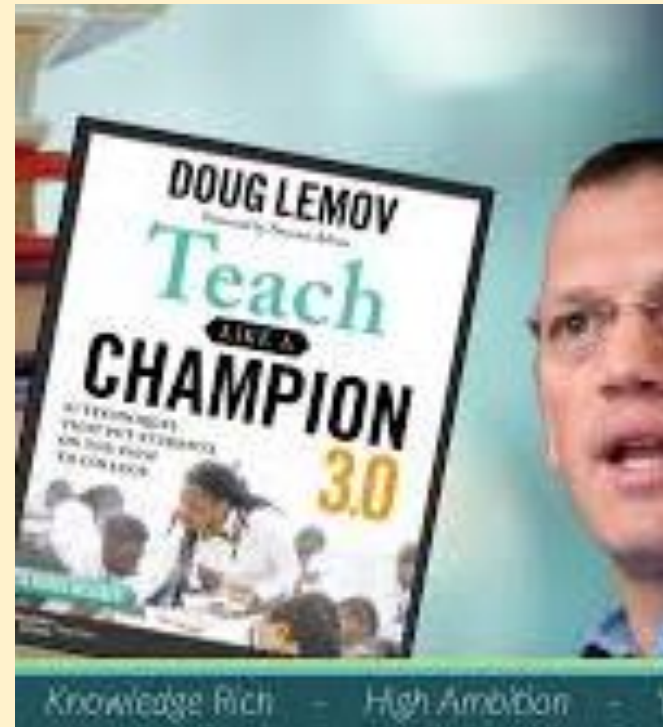


Students' Guide



As Clere Learners: we always

- 1** **SLANT:** Sit up, Listen, Answer questions, Never interrupt, Track the speaker (look at them)
- 2** **DNA:** Come in and start our task straight away. Use knowledge from our previous lessons
- 3** **COLD CALL:** Use thinking time and answer when the teacher asks us a question; no hands up
- 4** **RIGHT IS RIGHT:** Listen to the subject specific language and practise using it in our spoken and written answers
- 5** **SILENT SOLO:** Work on our own and in silence for the whole of the task. Work to the best of our ability
- 6** **TRACKING NOT WATCHING:** Use the feedback that is given to us as our teacher walks around the classroom
- 7** **SHOW CALL:** Watch the improvements being made on the screen and add it to our work to improve our performance
- 8** **HOME LEARNING:** Complete the tasks set and ask questions in advance of the deadline when unsure
