DOP:

72. The direct object pronoun replaces a noun which is the object of the sentence. The DOP must go in front of the verb. You must know the gender of the noun so you know which DOP to use eg:
 Je regarde la télé.
 Je la regarde.
 Tu manges les frites
 Tu les manges.
